We are thrilled, excited to learn and grow and especially looking forward to meeting the older adults in San Joaquin County. We are a small but mighty team of 20 including seven attorneys. Our practice areas are fairly broad and we support mostly in the following areas:

1. Foreclosure prevention/relief from wrongful foreclosure
2. Consumer debt
3. Tenant Rights: Notices to quit, Reasonable Accommodation, Eviction Defense, Rental Increases, Habitability
4. Advance Care Planning: wills, Powers of Attorney, Advance Healthcare Directives
5. Elder Abuse Prevention: Elder Abuse Restraining Orders, Post-scam counseling

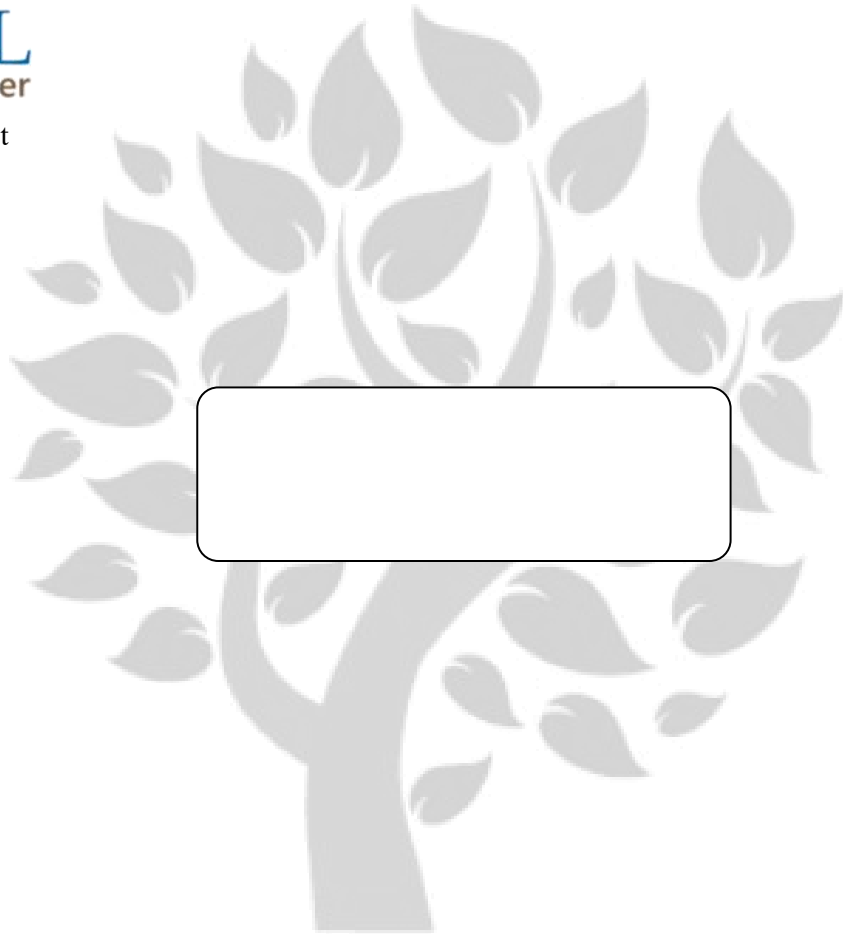
